The North Carolina School for the Deaf and the Eastern North Carolina School for the Deaf provide educational services in Pre-K through Grade 12 for North Carolina residents under 21 years of age who are deaf or hard-of-hearing, based on the county in which each student is domiciled. A student may be admitted if he or she meets the admissions criteria established for that school. In accordance with G.S. 115C-150.11(a), the State Board of Education has established the following geographic service areas for each school.
